Bid Bond shall be drawn in favor of the Board of Commissioners, Cobb County, Georgia, in the amount of five percent (5%) of the bid for the complete work.

The County will decide whether any Unit Prices are unbalanced either excessively above or below a reasonable cost analysis value determined by the Engineer, particularly if these unbalanced amounts are substantial and contrary to the interest on the County.

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I. QUESTIONS/ANSWERS

- Q. With such a large water package and very little other specialty subcontractor items, can the DBE % be calculated for the project without the water items, which are under a different entity?
- A. The DBE participation rate of 15% is based upon the availability of DBE contractors to perform work within all work item groups, and cannot be adjusted. Contractors should utilize GDOT's DBE Supportive Services if additional participation is needed to achieve the goal. They can be reached at www.dbesupport.com or 800-423-7058.
- Q. Will the County release earthwork files for Kennesaw Mountain Pedestrian Improvements Project?

A. Not available.

Q. According to the 641 section of the specifications guardrail is to be "Natina galvanized steel color or approved equal." Natina is a process that involves shipping the rail and anchors to Arizona to be treated then painted.

Would the county consider painting the guardrail in place in lieu of requiring the Natina process/product?

A. Yes, disregard the Natina process and follow process in Special Provision 641.3.05 E.
